We are proud to have funded the celebratory occasion marking 110 years of the Lily-White Rugby Football Club, in Adelaide. Players across many generations and some of the club's prominent supporters gathered to commemorate together, many of whom received special awards and acknowledgements for the contributions made to the club.

As part of the celebrations, we donated a three-piece playing kit for the 1st team, including 80 branded t-shirts, 20 golf shirts and 20 caps, as well as commemorative banners. The catering, decoration, and photography services were all locally sourced, contributing to local economic development.

ECD FUNDING SUPPORT PROGRAMME

As part of the exit strategy of our ECD Project, four Early Childhood Development centres from each of the beneficiary towns smiled all the way to the bank during this quarter, after each walked away with R25 000 cash prizes.

This project, established by Cookhouse Wind Farm in 2021, is now its second year of collaboration with Cookhouse Wind Farm Community Trust and Golden Valley Wind Farm. The aim of the project is to expose high school pupils to different study fields as well as provide support by way of bursaries and study loans.

A panel made up of Cookhouse Wind Farm and Early Inspiration, our training partner, settled on the four winners, namely, Khanyisa Pre-School in Adelaide; Kinder Joy ECD Centre, in Bedford; Msobomvu Family Development, in Cookhouse; and Klein Begin Dagsorg, in Somerset East.



COLLABORATION: CAREER AWARENESS PROJECT

More than 500 learners benefitted from a Career Awareness Project, which took place over a two-day period, earlier this year.

In collaboration with Cookhouse Wind Farm Community Trust and Golden Valley Wind Farm, Cookhouse Wind Farm established the project in 2021, with the view to exposing high school pupils to different study fields as well as providing support by way of bursaries and study loans.

As part of the project, 24 local youths were offered temporary employment as marshalls. Exhibitors at the event included all four universities from the Eastern Cape, two TVET colleges, two bursary management service providers and the Agri-SETA.



Local businesses also benefitted from the project as transport, catering, decoration, PA system, and videography services were secured locally.

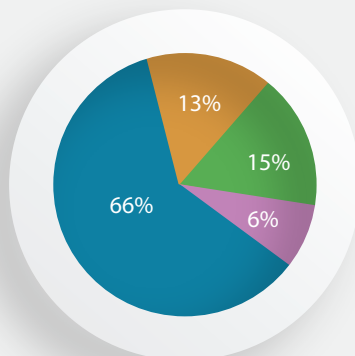
