



GROWING LOCAL TALENT THROUGH OUR INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME



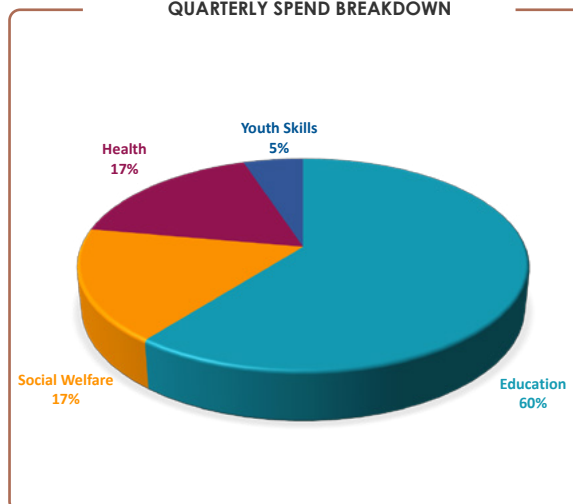
Our Social Performance Internship Programme kicked off earlier this year to give young graduates the chance to gain hands-on experience in the renewable energy space.
